ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER UNIT SEGMENT IS SELECTED
FOR NEW UPS FOR U.S. NAVY AEGIS DESTROYER
MK 119 GUN CONTROL SYSTEM

Potential Orders for MK 119 System Could Exceed \$1,000,000

Hauppauge, New York, February 3, 2004—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Units Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc. ("Behlman") has received an order totaling \$142,000 for a ruggedized uninterruptible power supply ("UPS") for the MK 119 gun control system used on the U.S. Navy's AEGIS Destroyers. Deliveries under this contract are expected in the second and third quarters of 2004.

Behlman was approached by the U.S. Navy in mid-2003 to provide a solution for problems associated with an existing UPS, because of Behlman's success in supplying the main power supply for the MK 119 system. Behlman received a development order in September 2003 and delivered a new unit that was approved in early January 2004 for use in the MK 119 system. As a result of this new opportunity, Behlman estimates that potential orders for the MK 119 system could exceed \$1,000,000. In addition to the MK 119 application, the unit is also designed for use by the military where ruggedized UPS's are needed.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO of Orbit, commented, "The significance of this award is far greater than the value of this contract because it is the culmination of an effort to supply a solution for our customer whereby Behlman was able to provide a direct replacement for a competitor's unit. In addition, this award enables Behlman to increase its presence on the MK 119 Gun Control System and we are hopeful that this success will lead to additional opportunities. Behlman's total solution approach to selling has created a strong demand for its products in niche applications".

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, inverters, uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for military and high-end industrial usage.
