ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER GROUP RECEIVES NEW ORDER

VALUED AT \$877,000

Power Group's Total Bookings for January 2012 Exceed \$1.9 Million

Hauppauge, New York, February 2, 2012 -- Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) ("Orbit") today announced that its Power Group, through its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary ("Behlman"), received a new production order for its COTS Division valued at \$877,000.

This COTS power supply is for an ongoing land-based satellite communications system program for which Behlman expects to continue to receive orders in 2012 and beyond. This is the fourth production order for this power supply and it represents the single largest order for these units received to date. Deliveries under this order are expected to begin in the third quarter of 2012 and continue through the first quarter of 2013.

Ronald Storm, Behlman's Vice President of Sales and Marketing commented, "Behlman's business remains strong across both our COTS and Commercial Divisions. The receipt of repeat production orders such as this one further validates Behlman's business model, which emphasizes flexible designs, individualized engineering support, and superior customer service. In addition to Behlman's niche business in COTS power solutions, we are committed to the development of standard products for both our Commercial and COTS Divisions which will form the basis of new product platforms to drive Behlman's continuing growth in the coming years."

Mitchell Binder, President and CEO of Orbit commented, "After a record year of bookings for our Power Group in 2011, Behlman's total orders for the month of January exceeded \$1.9 million. With a record backlog entering 2012 and this strong start in the month of January, we are confident that Behlman is well positioned for strong operating performance in the current year."

Orbit International Corp. is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications through its production facilities in Hauppauge, New York, and Quakertown, Pennsylvania; and designs and manufactures combat systems

and gun weapons systems, provides system integration and integrated logistics support and documentation control at its facilities in Louisville, Kentucky. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, uninterruptible power supplies and COTS power solutions.
