**ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER GROUP RECEIVES NEW ORDER VALUED
AT APPROXIMATELY \$1,334,000**

**Exclusive of this New Order, Power Group's 2011 Record Bookings through November 30th
Up Over 26% From the Same Period of the Prior Year**

Hauppauge, New York, December 14, 2011 -- Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Group, through its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary ("Behlman"), has received an order for a power supply used in oil and gas exploration valued at approximately \$1,334,000. Deliveries are expected to begin in the third quarter of 2012 and continue through the fourth quarter of 2013.

Behlman has been supplying its customer with this unit since 1995 and to date has shipped over 1,500 units. This order brings the total value of orders received for this unit in 2011 to approximately \$2.5 million. In addition, Behlman's 2011 bookings remain strong and have exceeded the previous annual record. Exclusive of this new order, bookings for the Power Group through November 30th are up over 26% from the same period of last year.

Mark Tublisky, President of Behlman commented, "Our commitment to building products of the highest quality and reliability has enabled us to secure and maintain these types of long-term business relationships. We have been a reliable source of supply on this program for over 15 years and we remain confident that we will continue to receive follow-on orders from our customer."

Mitchell Binder, President and CEO of Orbit International commented, "We are very encouraged by the growth in sales in both divisions of our Power Group. Not only has Behlman's COTS Division achieved record bookings in 2011, but with this order our Commercial Division has done so as well. Overall, our Power Group's record bookings and revenue achieved in 2011 have validated a key part of its business strategy; developing long-term OEM business relationships, which we believe will continue to drive the growth of Behlman's business in 2012 and beyond."

Orbit International Corp. is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications through its production facilities in Hauppauge, New York, and Quakertown, Pennsylvania; and designs and manufactures combat systems

and gun weapons systems, provides system integration and integrated logistics support and documentation control at its facilities in Louisville, Kentucky. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, uninterruptible power supplies and COTS power solutions.
